

NWMHC 2026 HIGH POINT BELT BUCKLE SERIES

Molly's Custom Silver Belt Buckles will be awarded in each of these categories:

High Point Amateur/Single Horse (qualifying classes 104, 109, 115, 121, 123, 125, 157, 158, 159, 164, 189, 192, 205, 211, 219, 226, 227, 245, 246)

High Point Amateur/Multiple Horses (qualifying classes – same as the amateur/single)

High Point Carriage (qualifying classes 137, 144, 201, 213, 242)

High Point Cool (qualifying classes 112, 119, 120, 148, 208, 240, 241)

High Point Driving Horse (qualifying classes 132, 149, 154, 155, 156, 162, 163, 168, 169, 170, 176, 178, 179, 187, 188, 193, 215, 216, 249, 250, 251, 260, 261, 262)

High Point Performance Horse (qualifying classes 105, 110, 114, 171, 195, 206, 212)

High Point VSE (qualifying classes 101, 106, 113, 134, 138, 139, 146, 153, 196, 202, 218, 252, 253)

High Point Youth/Single Horse (qualifying classes – all of the classes listed under each age division below)

High Point Youth/Multiple Horses (qualifying classes – all of the classes listed under each age division below)

High Point 7 & Under (qualifying classes 103, 108, 111, 118, 133, 145, 182, 186, 194, 204, 207, 210, 222, 235, 239, 255)

High Point 8 – 12 (qualifying classes 103, 108, 117, 133, 136, 166, 181, 185, 194, 204, 210, 214, 222, 234, 238, 255, 268)

High Point 13 – 18 (qualifying classes 102, 107, 116, 133, 135, 165, 180, 184, 194, 203, 209, 214, 217, 222, 233, 237, 267)

Rules: Any exhibitor **may qualify** for a High Point Belt Buckle by showing at any one of these three shows. Club membership is not required. To qualify for a category, you must show in at least 3 different qualifying classes listed for that category. Championship classes do not count or give additional points.

Amateur/Single Horse, Cool, and Youth/Single Horse points will be totaled for each horse/handler team. The team with the most points in those categories over the series wins. High Point Amateur/Multiple Horses, High Point Youth/Multiple Horses: points for all horses an amateur or youth show will be totaled. If an amateur or youth has the most points in both their Single and Multiple Horse categories, they will be awarded the Multiple Horse buckle, then the next highest pointed amateur or youth with a Single Horse will be awarded the Single Horse buckle. Youths that win the Single or Multiple Horse buckles are not eligible to win the Youth age categories, 7 & Under, 8 to 12, 13 to 18, those categories will be awarded to the next highest pointed youth in line.

Carriage, Driving Horse, Performance Horse, and VSE points will be totaled for each horse. The horse with the most points in those categories over the series wins.

Points for placements: 1st place=7pts, 2nd place=6pts, 3rd place=5pts, 4th place=4pts, 5th place=3pts, 6th place=2pts, additional youth class placements: 7th place=1pt, 8th place=1/2pt. Ties will be broken in the following manner: most first places, most second places, and if a tie still remains a flip of coin will determine the winner. Series High Points Buckles will be awarded 60 minutes after completion of the Emerald Valley Classic Show or once all tabulations are finished. Awards must be picked up by eligible winners or their representative at this time. Failure to pick up an award will result in forfeiture and the award will be given to the next highest point in line. Awards will NOT be shipped. High Point standings will be posted on the NWMHC website after each of the first 2 shows and winners will be posted after the last show.
