

NWMHC FUTURITY RULES (as amended at 2/25/2018 meeting)

1. Foal must be nominated in- utero no later than March 1st following year of breeding.
2. Both sire and dam must be registered with the AMHA. The owners of the pregnant mare, at the time of nomination, must be members of the NWMHC. The resulting foal must be AMHA registered and owned by members of the NWMHC to be eligible to participate in the Futurity classes.
3. Futurity forms may be obtained on the NWMHC website or from the Futurity Chairperson. Mail these entries along with the appropriate fee to the NWMHC Futurity Chairperson. All checks should be made payable to the NWMHC Futurity.
4. Seven Futurity classes will be held:
 - Yearling Colts
 - Yearling Fillies
 - Yearling Geldings
 - Two-Year-Old Colts
 - Two-Year-Old Fillies
 - Two-Year-Old Geldings
 - Three Year Old Pleasure Driving
5. The Yearling Futurity classes will be held at the Can-Am Classic and the Two- Year-Old Futurity and the Three Year Old Pleasure Driving Futurity classes will be held at the Emerald Valley Classic.
6. All horses are to be shown under the current AMHA rules.

7. Fee Schedule

Halter Futurities:

Nomination by March 1 st following year of breeding	\$10.00
Sustaining by March 1 st of Yearling Futurity year.....	\$15.00
Sustaining by March 1 st of Two Year Old Futurity year.....	\$20.00
Class entry before starting time of Emerald Valley Classic (Two-Year-Olds).....	\$35.00
Class entry before starting time of Can-Am Classic (Yearling).....	\$35.00

Pleasure Driving Futurity:

Nomination by March 1 st following the year of breeding	\$10.00
Sustaining by March 1 st of the Three year old year Pleasure Driving Futurity year.....	\$25.00
Class entry before starting time of Emerald Valley Classic (Pleasure Driving).....	\$35.00

Entries must be received prior to the first horse walking into the ring for the first class of the show. Emerald Valley classic show for 2 Year olds and 3 year olds. Can/Am classic show for Yearlings. **Post entries are not allowed in Futurity classes under any circumstances.**

8. Late Fees: In order to avoid late fees, all forms must be postmarked on or before March 1st and must be accompanied with the appropriate fees. However, if you miss the deadline, you may still:

- a. Nominate your mare in utero at 2 times the normal nominating fee.
- b. Buy in a foal born to an un-nominated mare at any time by paying 2 times the normal nominating fee. They will then be subject to the rest of the Futurity rules and deadlines.
- c. Sustain a yearling at 2 times the normal sustaining fee no later than the published closing date of the show hosting the yearling Futurity classes.
- d. Sustain a two year old at 2 times the normal sustaining fee no later than the published closing date of the show hosting the two year old Futurity classes.

All other Futurity rules must be followed. Post entries are not allowed for any Futurity class.

- 9. Nominated foals do not have to show prior to the Futurity classes.
- 10. In the event a foal is sold before the Futurity class, eligibility can be transferred to the new owner. The seller should provide the Futurity information to the new owner and contact the Futurity Chairperson so the records can be updated. The new owner must be a member of the NWMHC and pay the appropriate fees when they come due to keep the horse eligible. They should also provide a copy of the AMHA papers noting ownership transfer.
- 11. Refunds of initial nomination fee will be made only in the event of a foal being stillborn or in the event the mare was proved not to be in foal. A veterinarian's statement should be sent to the Futurity Chairperson. If a mare aborts the nominated foal, the nomination cannot be transferred to another mare.
- 12. All monies, except for the cost of awards, will become prize money for the Futurity classes. The Futurity Chairperson will maintain records and the Club Treasurer/Secretary will hold the monies.
- 13. Halter Futurity dollars available for each class shall be calculated in the following manner for each year's foal crop. The nomination fees, yearling sustaining fees and 2 year old sustaining fees are accumulated for each year's foal crop:

Divide the Dollars Available by the total number of yearling or 2 year olds actually entered to get the amount allocated per horse, then multiply that by the number of mares, or stallions, or geldings to get the total amount of dollars available for that class. The Payout for each placement is then calculated by the percentage shown on the following chart according to the number of horses entered in the class up to 10th place.

14. 3 Year Old Pleasure Driving Futurity will be held at the Emerald Valley Classic. This Class will include all sexes and driving disciplines. 100% of Nomination fees, sustaining and Entry fees will be available for pay out using the percentage chart below placing up to 10th place.
